Hello,

My name is Carley Styron, I live at 2411 15th ave, Milton wa 98354. I am here to tell you about a petition that was submitted to the City Council on July 11th with the hope to rename the Lower Milton Field. Our family has spent many years on the Lower Milton Field including my son, Carson Trey Styron. My husband coached Carson on this field for many years. Carson umpired on this field and assistant coached with his Dad for his little brothers team. Carson was in a fatal ATV accident on June, 5th 2016.

We would like to rename the Lower Milton field in Carson's name as a memorial to him and the values he represented. He loved the game of baseball to be a part of a team, a leader. Carson was a friend to kids that had no friends and encouraged them in times of need. He was student of the year at Surprise Lake in 2014 and received the presidential award.

Our intention is not to take over the field, but to bring the community, including the Council, together to improve the field. Some ideas we have are to remove the telephone pole parking lot curbs and put in nice planters. We would also like to number the fields, add a bench and possibility cover the bleachers. These are some of our ideas. We have a fund set up in Carson's name and would like to use the money to fund these improvements.
