Commissioner Whalen briefed the Commission on some of the differences between the 99 corridor and the uptown area with regard to signage needs, including slower traffic, more pedestrian oriented, and a sense of gathering place/main street feel.

Chair Gillespie suggested a round-robin approach to thoughts and suggestions. Discussion then ensued, including:

- Consistency in signs below awnings
- Maximum sign size
- Signage on multiple frontages
- Backlit canopies
- Pole signs, and width of poles
- Monument signs, min and max size
