Recommendation/Action: "I move to approve the following actions:

- i. Approve the attached ordinance obtaining a loan from the Electric Utility Fund to the General Fund for an amount not to exceed \$55,000 for a period of three years at the current LGIP interest rate, and
- ii. Approve the attached amended ordinance making the necessary budget adjustments to reflect the above expenditures and loan, and
- iii. Authorize the Mayor to execute all necessary documents to accomplish the same."

Previous Council Review: On October 6, 2014, Police Chief Hernandez provided brief background and discussion to the Finance Committee concerning the state of the police fleet and the need for both immediate replacement as well as the establishment of a future replacement schedule.

Discussion: Based on the memo provided by Chief Hernandez, if an additional budget appropriation for the purpose of addressing immediate fleet needs within the police department is approved, the adoption of the attached ordinances would be required.

SUBJECT: Emergency Budget Appropriation Request (Fleet Vehicle)

DATE: October 16, 2014

A Milton Police Department vehicle #848 a 2006 Crown Victoria incurred a major transmission failure on October 15 2014. The Milton Police Department vehicles are kept running as long as practical and as is cost- effective. But there has not been sufficient funding available to practice cost- effective replacement cycling. In addition to the maintenance backlogs inherent in the City of Milton fleet in its current condition, Milton Police are operating vehicles until vehicles are to be slated as junked or considered dead lined from active service, leaving the Milton Police Department short vehicles with no notice. While these forced retirements cannot always be anticipated (as in this particular case of sudden accidental damage), most vehicles are retired for reasons other than accidents, most long anticipated. The current state of the fleet is a direct result of the age of the fleet and the lack of an (ER&R) Equipment and Repair & Replacement Fund plan, this with no notice, combined with the lack of pool vehicles, leaves the Police Department short for months or longer, until a new vehicle can be allocated. The current hardship will also short patrol and will force operations to take the Reserve Officers vehicle limiting our surge capacity and response capabilities. With that being said I am asking for an emergency budget appropriation to replace vehicle #846.

ORDINANCE 14-XXXX**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON;
AMENDING ORDINANCE 14-1851 TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF
THE INTERFUND LOAN FROM 40,000 TO 55,000 FROM THE
ELECTRIC UTILITY FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND IN AN AMOUNT
NOT TO EXCEED \$55,000 FOR THE PURPOSES OF PURCHASING AN
TWO ADDITIONAL POLICE PATROL VEHICLES; PROVIDING FOR
SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, funds are needed by the General Fund for costs associated with the purchase an outfitting of one (2) additional police patrol vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the city expects the funds loaned to be repaid by Property Tax revenues or other resources identified by the City.

WEAREAS, the Milton Police department has an opportunity to purchase two police vehicles for an increased saving due to the scale of economy by purchasing two vehicles at the same time.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Milton do ordain as follows:

Section1. A loan in the amount not to exceed \$55,000 is hereby authorized from the Electric Utility Fund to the General Fund. The loan shall be repaid from Property Tax revenues, or other authorized funds, within three years. Interest shall be at the rate of 1.0 percent per annum.

Section2. The Finance Director is authorized to advance funds ffrom the Electric Utility Fund to the General Fund as authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance for the purpose of this interfund loan. The Finance Director is authorized and directed to repay sums advanced from monies received by the General Fund, plus interest, as required in Section 1.

Section 3. **Severability.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by State or Federal law or regulations, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. **Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force five (5) days after passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON;
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14-1838 FURTHER AMENDING THE
ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF MILTON FOR THE FISCAL
YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2014; PROVIDING FOR
SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Milton City Council adopted the 2014 budget pursuant to Ordinance 13-1833; and

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2014 the Milton City Council amended Ordinance 13-1833 by adopting Ordinance 14-1838; and

WHEREAS, this adjustment will amend Ordinance 14-1838, adjusting the previously amended 2014 budget for budget impacts related to the adoption of Ordinance 14-1851, an interfund loan between the Electric Utility Fund and the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, this adjustment will amend Ordinance 14-1852, adjusting the previously amended 2014 budget for budget impacts related to the adoption of Ordinance 14-####, an interfund loan between the Electric Utility Fund and the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, previous budget ordinances are being amended to reflect changes in order to stay in compliance with the State Auditor; **NOW THEREFORE**,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The 2014 budget, as adopted through Ordinance 13-1833, Ordinance 14-1838, and Ordinance 14-1852 is hereby further amended as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

Section 2. **Severability.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by State or Federal law or regulations, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 3. **Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become effective and be in full force five (5) days after passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
