Park Board Members present were: Beverly Webber, Kent Ross, Robert MacDonald, Mike Rutter, and Linda Goddard.


City Attorney Bio Park from the firm of Ogden Murphy Wallace provided legal orientation to members of the City Council, Planning Commission and Park Board members.
