Call to Order: Meeting called to order in Milton Council Chambers at 6:07 by Susan Johnson; Sandy Parr recording.

Roll Call: Susan Johnson, Sandy Parr, April Balsley, Mary Tompkins, Debra Hooie, Brandy Wade and Teresa Cosner. Karen Yokota and Nitisha were excused. Motion to excuse by D. Hooie and seconded by M. Tompkins. Tom Boyle has resigned from the committee.

Volunteer/Visitors: Josef Lowry, Edgewood Karate Academy, Claire Berry, Zumba, and Matthew Barnes and Thomas Poirier, Old Coots on Scoots.

Approval of Minutes: The July 9, 2014 minutes were approved with correction to let the City determine the location of the Cyclone Swing in contact with Clowns Unlimited. Motion to accept as amended by A. Balsley and seconded by M. Tompkins.

Open Business: Committee approved the schedule. A. Balsley added Milton Days to the FME Chamber of Commerce facebook page and passed out flyers for the Edgewood Picnic.

Tshirts will be sold at Albertsons on July 26, August 2, and August 9<sup>th</sup>. The car wash will be held on July 26<sup>th</sup> at Albertson's from 10am to 2:30pm. \$90 has been turned in for t-shirt sales so far. Members will donate pizza for the workers at the car wash. Phil Waldner of Fife Towing presented a \$1500 check to the City of Milton. Susan will email N. Coleman about her daughter doing the donkey sign. T. Cosner motioned to approve \$30 for the mule design project, seconded by S. Parr.

Umpqua Bank asked permission to bring their ice cream truck to the car show. The committee approved. 34 emails have been sent out to interested car show people. M. Barnes has the trophies. M. Barnes needs to be in contact with Les Schwab.

VFW Post Commander Jack Chandler will be in conversation with the Rangers.

M. Tompkins made a motion to approve \$4,472.88 for the Clowns Unlimited contract. The contract calls for ½ down and motion was made and seconded by D. Hooie. The entertainment stage will be delivered on August 14. Members should be at park on August 15, 16, and 17. Motion made to order more tshirts at a 10% discount in the amount of 200 with final approval by the mayor; seconded by B. Wade. Tshirts will be sold at the Seahawk booth and a committee

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member must be present at all times to receive money. Northwest Embroidery donated 50 volunteer tshirts. Lanyards will be made for committee members.

S. Johnson thanked T. Cosner for all her fundraising efforts. The Milton Police and City will arrange for the nighttime security. Brandy reported 40 vendors and possibly 14 more coming in. There will be five antique trucks. Jose Brook and Jubel from Radio 92.5 will talk about Milton Days for two weeks before Milton Days. Jubel will introduce the PopOffs.

J. Lowry from Edgewood Karate will provide signs with date and activities and directional signs.
