<b>PROPOSAL:</b>	The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT), Puget Sound Gateway Program, is hereby submitting application for a Shoreline Conditional Use Permit for the subject project. The project will construct a new State Route (SR) 509 Spur alignment between SR 509 and Interstate 5 (I-5) and a new portion of SR 167 alignment between I-5 and 20th Street East, and associated riparian restoration and wetland mitigation within the cities of Tacoma, Fife, Milton, Edgewood, and Unincorporated Pierce County, Washington.

<b>SEPA:</b>	The Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) is lead agency in accordance with the lead agency rules in WAC 197-11-922. WSDOT has previously conducted

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environmental review of the Puget Sound Gateway Program, and will re-evaluate whether any new significant environmental impacts will occur that were not previously evaluated in the 2006 Final EIS (FEIS).
