

CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 1929-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILTON, PIERCE COUNTY AND KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE REGULAR TAX LEVY FOR PROPERTIES LOCATED IN PIERCE AND KING COUNTY FOR THE YEAR 2018; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION BY ORDINANCE TITLE ONLY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milton has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City's actual levy amount from the previous year was \$1,131,694.54; and

WHEREAS, the population of the City is less than 10, 000; and

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2018 tax year.

Section 1. That the dollar amount of the increase over the actual levy amount from the previous year shall be \$203,322.20 which is a percentage increase of 17.966174% from the previous year. This increase is exclusive of additional revenue resulting from the addition of

new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
