DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

City of Milton 2019 Shoreline Master Program Periodic Review Amendments

The City proposes to amend its SMP consistent with requirements under the Shoreline Management Act (SMA) to review, and if necessary, revise its SMP at least once every eight years. RCW 90.58.080 specifies the deadline for the City to review, amend and adopt an amended SMP by June 30, 2019. These amendments are intended to ensure consistency between the City's SMP and laws and guidelines that may have changed since the City last updated its SMP.

PROPONENT:

City of Milton

LOCATION OF PROPOSAL:

Applies within the City's shoreline jurisdiction, which includes waters of statewide significance and land areas within 200' of their ordinary high water mark. In Milton, this includes Surprise Lake and portions of the Hylebos Creek (from the City's southern border to approximately Comet Street).

LEAD AGENCY:

City of Milton

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment and an environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2) (c), provided the mitigation measures are conducted concurrent with the project. This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

- This DNS is issued after using the optional DNS process in WAC 197-11-355. There is no further comment period on the DNS.
- This DNS is issued under WAC 197-11-340; the lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date below.
