ORDINANCE NO 1976-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS OF FACT AND AMENDING THE 2019 BUDGET ADOPTED WITH ORDINANCE NO. 1954-18 ON DECEMBER 3, 2018 AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE, AND FOR SUMMARY PUBLICATION BY ORDINANCE TITLE ONLY.

WHEREAS, the Milton City Council adopted the 2019 Budget with Ordinance No. 1954-18 on December 3, 2018; and

WHEREAS, 2019 General Fund revenues are significantly higher than projected for sales tax, plan review fees and building permits; and

WHEREAS, building and planning department professional services expenditures are higher than planned due to the significant volume of applications which are more than offset by increased revenues; and

WHEREAS, court costs are expected to be higher than budgeted; and

WHEREAS, additional services are needed for the Street Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City of Milton to increase the 2019 Budget by \$340,000; and

WHEREAS, this will not result in a decreased fund balance in any fund; and

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The above stated recitals are hereby adopted as the council's findings and reasons for the adoption of this ordinance.

Section 2. The 2019 Budget, as adopted with Ordinance 1954-18 is hereby amended with an increase of \$340,000 to revenues and resources and \$340,000 to expenditures as detailed in the attached exhibit (Exhibit A – Proposed Budget Amendment).


Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.
