CALL TO ORDER

REGULAR AGENDA

A. First Quarter 2020 Financial Report

Finance Director Michelle Robbecke presented this item to council. Director Robbecke went through the 2020 Budget Position report highlighting revenues and expenses and commented on anything that was different than the expected 25%.

Council asked some clarifying questions on the report and were satisfied with the results of it.

B. SR 99 Transpo Contract

Public Works Director Afzali presented this item to council with a PowerPoint slide show. Director Afzali explained the process for receiving applications, interviewing applicants and ultimately choosing a consultant for this project. The slide show also briefly outlined the project and what it could be expected to look like by the summer of 2021.

Councilmembers asked some questions regarding the layout of the project and grant budget funding for the project.

C. Street/Alley Vacation Code Update Ordinance 1987-20

Public Works Director Afzali presented this item to council. MMC Chapter 12.06 is proposed to be changed to allow the City to charge the full appraised amount unless vacated land has been dedicated for less than 25 years. There is also a proposed increase for the filing fee from \$250 to \$500 to defray administrative cost associated with the vacation petition and related procedures.

Council didn't have any questions on this item but did express that since it hadn't been updated in many years, that it was time.
