



CALL FOR ARTISTS

UTILITY BOX ART WRAP PROJECT

The City of Milton is committed to the beautification of our city and supporting a vibrant artistic community. One of our newest ventures is our Utility Box Art Wrap Project.

These metal boxes are located throughout our city and are often not very visually interesting. Our idea is to turn the utility boxes into a way to strengthen Milton's identity and sense of community through art wraps applied to the utility boxes. The art will be located on utility boxes that are in highly visible areas. Artists should design art wraps for one of these four locations (or all).



LOCATION ONE

The corner of Milton Way and Freeman Road

LOCATION TWO

The corner of Porter Way and Milton Way.



LOCATION THREE

The corner of Milton Way and 23rd (by the skatepark.)

LOCATION FOUR

The corner of Milton Way and 27th.



PROJECT DETAILS

The City of Milton is accepting applications from artists for innovative designs and family-oriented illustrations with bold shapes and engaging colors. We are offering a \$400 stipend for original images used for the project.

Applicants are invited to submit up to four conceptual renderings for consideration. They may be a sketch or a completed illustration done with any media.

The illustrations or sketches should be turned into digital submissions, if possible. All artwork should be original. Please see page 2 for dimensions for artwork.

Interested artists may submit illustrations that fit the theme of the box and the size and shape restrictions for one or more boxes.

The selection committee will evaluate and choose from the artwork submitted. Art work will not be returned.

Selected artists will be contacted to discuss the next step in getting art on the boxes. Final artwork will be digitized, transferred to vinyl, and installed on the utility box.

Please note these guidelines:

1. Submit your image/application in a format that will fit the templates included on pages 2-3 of this application.
2. Art will be selected based on its overall strength and visual appeal of design concept.
3. Artistic innovation will also be considered.
4. Artworks must be original.

NEW DEADLINE: Submissions are due by **Friday, October 30th at 5 p.m.** Check cityofmilton.net for an update on the selection process. Please note that application materials will not be returned.

Please complete this application form and submit the following supplemental information:

- Submit up to 4 conceptual renderings, preferably in a high-resolution digital format (ie: PDF, EPS, PNG, AI file). Application materials cannot be returned. Artwork should be original and created by the artist submitting the piece.
- Please supply a brief artist's statement describing your piece. If desired, explain the connection of your piece and any theme you focused on.
- Please note for which utility box you are submitting (if only submitting one).

Project information:

- Selected artists will be paid a stipend of \$400, which allows the City of Milton the rights to use the image as seen fit.
- Artists will be notified only if selected.

Applicant information:

Artist agrees by signing below and submitting this application that while all submitted art is owned by the Artist, the images may be used by The City of Milton in the City's Utility Box Art Program and any applicable promotional materials. While the Artist retains ownership of all submitted art, Artist agrees to not permit the selected art to be displayed publicly for any similar project located within 20 miles of Milton.








Create your art piece to match template measurements below. Note, measurements are different for all four locations. Templates done at 50%
