Agenda Items:

Chief Rhodes requesting a Sergeant's list. We lost our Sergeant two years ago. We have had acting Sergeants filling in. They receive 10% over their regular salary when in that acting position. Would like to have a list to fill this position from. We have three-four that are interested. Even if we can't hire yet, it's good for the officers to go through the process. He borrowed an assessment test/process from Bonney Lake. It has policy/procedures, what if questions. It is also scenario based to see how they will make decisions. We will run the test August 17th. MOTION to allow Debe to prepare a Sergeant's list Gerry, 2nd Maggie, approved 4-0.

We will move the **August meeting to August 28** instead of the 21 due to a conflict in Debe's schedule.

Police Report

City Council heard comments on changing the fireworks law. Voted 4-3 to keep current law in place. There are provisions for fireworks as long as the people go through the correct permits, licenses, etc.

City Council repealed the helmet ordinance. City was contacting by the insurance authority. They said if we can't monitor the skate park (helmet law) 100% of the time, we were liable. There are other calls that take precedence so they repealed that part of the ordinance. Repealing the whole ordinance also removes the requirement for bicycle helmets.

Budget wise – we're still looking at options. Looking @ dispatch service. South Sound 911 passed. Fife will be going to that down the road. Still talking to Puyallup about their system. SS911 is too expensive. With the Puyallup plan, we would save about \$50-60K/year.

Former Detective Wada had a heart attack but is doing well. He is scheduled to have a triple bypass at St Joseph.
