Police Report

Wished we had more names on the lateral list. It is much more cost effective to hire from that. Have heard there are others who are interested. Will contact them and encourage them to test through PST. If they do, there is a potential to run another oral board to increase the list.

The assessors for the oral board did a great job. Chief met with them prior and said – do us a favor – don't pass them if you wouldn't want to work with them. They said that we had some really good candidates on the list.

Lakewood's list is down from 10 to 4 names. One of our officers is still on the list. We hope to know by late April/early May.

At the council retreat, they didn't get to discuss the police budget, so we don't know about an additional officer position yet.

We have a provisional who has worked at Fife. He is doing well. We have two currently out and one won't be back until October.

Daytime burglaries are on the rise.
